About the Webinar

The outbreak of the coronavirus pandemic has fuelled the demand of medical gloves hence the export market for medical gloves will possibly reach a new high in 2021. Nonetheless, growth will stabilize as the pandemic situation subsides. This market study embarks on another speciality glove segment, focusing on gloves for medical purposes and procedures such as latex gloves for radiation, chemotherapy, gynaecological and dental. The US and EU markets, primarily in 5 countries Germany, France, UK, Italy and Spain dominates the global medical disposable gloves market with a combined share of 70.6% of the market demand, estimated at USD 29.6 billion in 2020. The US market alone accounts for 46.5% of the total market. The future projections remain strong for both markets with an estimated CAGR of 9.8% for US and 9.2% for the EU markets respectively between 2020 and 2027.
