Gloves play a crucial role throughout the different stages of food industry operations, including production, processing, packaging, and food preparation, serving to prevent contamination. In the USA, demand for food handling gloves is primarily driven by three food sectors: food servicing, food processing, and food packaging. Malaysia's

export of food handling gloves grew from RM33.0 million in 2015 to RM125.2 million in 2019 recording a strong CAGR of 39.6% and the USA remained the largest export market for Malaysian food handling gloves in 2022 constituting 41.2% in value, followed by Japan 28.4% and Spain 20.6%.
