This market update will highlight and present the findings identified from the market research study by MRC. Participants will acquire information on market entry strategies to increase the exports of rubber retread materials, the market sizes, the supply and distribution channel as well as consumption patterns, procurement practices and purchasing requirements in key sectors. The study will assess opportunities for rubber retreading in ASEAN as well as identifying opportunities for Malaysian exporters. About the MIS

Global retreaded tyre market is expected to grow at 4.4% CAGR from USD 7 8 billion in 2020 to reach USD 101 billion in 2026, on the account of factors such as cost effectiveness in comparison to new tyres, increasing global vehicle, parc leading to higher maintenance and repairing needs, growing environmental concerns and improvements in retreaded tyre quality. Prior to the global pandemic crisis in 2020, global exports of retreaded tyres were increasing steadily at 3.8% CAGR from USD 608.2 million in 2016 to USD 679.2 million in 2019. Exports of retreaded tyres plunged 19% to USD 551.4 million in 2020. Future Market Insights (FMI) projects that the global retreaded tyre market will increase as the economy pulls through after the pandemic's containment era, growing at 4.7% CAGR through 2031.
