**MRC DONATES RM228,000 FOR FLASH FLOOD EMERGENCY RELIEF
MISSION TO 550 RESIDENTS IN KEDAH**

YAN, 30 AUGUST 2021 – MRC channelled a contribution of RM228,000 to flash flood victims in Yan and Kuala Muda District, Kedah through the Emergency Relief Mission together with Muslim Care Malaysia Society (MCMS), today.

A total of 550 locals in the Yan and Gurun areas as recipients of this contribution will be receiving basic necessities and food to help ease the burden of those suffering from the damage to their property as a result of the flash floods that hit the areas since August 18th.

Among the recipients today include the rubber smallholders from Kampung Jawa, Yan.

Encik Nurul Islam Mohamed Yusoff, CEO of MRC presented a mock cheque along with the basic necessities to Encik Zulkifli Wahijan, President of MCMS, witnessed by YB Ustaz Mohd Azam Abd Samat, State Assemblyman of Sungai Limau, during the handing over of the contribution at the Flood Relief Collection Center and Jerai Disaster Operations Room, Al-Wustha Mosque, Guar Cempedak.

Each family will receive one (1) set of basic food donation bags including rice, sugar, salt, eggs, cooking oil and others as well as basic necessities such as a set of toiletries or personal cleaning kit, toto and worship attires.

Other additional needs such as gas cylinders/14kg (filled) and gas stoves will also be provided for families in need.

MRC will continue to be committed to providing assistance to communities in need affected by the occurrence of undesirable difficulties through Bantuan Prihatin MRC which is one of the initiatives under the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) program.
