**MRC CONTRIBUTES RM270,000 TO PKRC MAEPS, SERDANG IN
FACING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC CRISIS**

KUALA LUMPUR, 15 AUGUST 2021 – Malaysian Rubber Council (MRC) presented medical items worth RM270,000 to the Low-Risk COVID-19 Quarantine and Treatment Centres (PKRC) at MAEPS, Serdang.

As an effort to assist the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH), this donation is a continuation of MRC's Bantuan Prihatin Programme to help the government ease the burden and duties of frontliners who are struggling to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic crisis.

The donation ceremony was officiated by the Minister of Plantation Industries and Commodities, YB Dato' Dr Mohd Khairuddin Aman Razali, to PKRC MAEPS Director Dr Sahabuddin Ibrahim. Also present was MRC Chief Executive Officer Encik Nurul Islam Mohamed Yusoff.

At the ceremony, Plantation Industries and Commodities Minister handed over five units of laptops worth RM10,000; 2,500 units of personal protective equipment (PPE) Tyvek suits worth RM225,000 and 5,000 units of N95 face masks worth RM35,000. [END]
